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North Division Operations:

We are hoping for a winding down of fire season with the latest round of precipitation. The Engines are scheduled to downstaff to 1-engine per station. If weather continues to be wet, more downstaffing is anticipated.

Construction is continuing on the new Boggs Mountain Forest Office on the 500 road.

The new helicopter has been delayed on delivery, now anticipated to be February 2021.

Progress is being made on the Station 31 remodel and asbestos removal project, with an anticipated 'move-in' date of February, 2021. Fire Season 2020 put the brakes on the project temporarily.

2 new HFEO positions have been added to Konocti Camp Shop to assist with repairs and maintenance.

Camp Operations:

Crew numbers continue to be a challenge. Konocti has 2 crews currently staffed at 13-14 per crew.

8 Camps are scheduled to be 'depopulated' due to low inmate numbers. 4 of those are in the North, and 4 in the South. No LNU Camps were on this initial list. Unknown if more 'depopulations' are on the way. In general, a 'depopulation' is not a closure, it is relocating inmates and CDCR crews to other camps, but keeping CAL FIRE personnel at the Camp to ensure maintenance and upkeep.

Konocti Camp served as base camp for several locals incidents in the month of October.

South Lake Operations:

The new Medic 6311 was put into service with all the radio installs completed.

The new SCBA's under the Lake County \$970,000 FEMA Grant have been ordered, and should be in the county during the first week of December. The process will be for them to be assembled and tested by the vendor once they are delivered to North Shore Fire. After testing, we will begin the installation and refitting of the SCBA's into our equipment.

There is a potential for us to 'find a home' for the old SCBA's, but since they do not meet the current safety requirements, this needs to be researched prior to releasing them to another Department, in order to avoid a liability on South Lake.

Hidden Valley Station 63 now has a custom fabricated, installed Fire Escape to their second story bedroom window so they have a way out in case of a fire.

OES359 with PCFs and Staff responded to the recent fires in Orange County.

Water Rescue, Snowcat, Rescue/Rope, Live Fire Training (Fire Control 3), and Driver Training are all on the list for this winter. We pay for all of these class's out of the ABH Funds identified for Training, Equipment and Branding.

On 11-12-2020 Staff responded to a structure fire in Hidden Valley Lake. A quick and efficient response from staff saved the structure and stopped the attic fire. While the home still has significant roof damage, most of the home, from the walls down, was undamaged with light smoke damage. There were 8 new Thermal Imaging Cameras that were at the scene of this Fire. This was our first Fire since the cameras were purchased through a donation from a family in Hidden Valley. They worked very, very well. Thermal Imager technology is a game changer, especially during overhaul.

The Hidden Valley Lake Station 63 expansion evaluation is ongoing. We are waiting on the Surveyors report. There is discussion with the County about structure set backs. HVLA already has a plan to move the mail boxes when needed.

We did not receive FEMA funding for SCBAs and Engines for SLCF. We will apply again for Engines.

Our recent Fire Sirens Wish List for \$20,000.00 was approved to purchase Firefighting tools and equipment.

We have received verbal notification of two \$5,000.00 grants for a total of \$10,000.00 to purchase 13 road signs and 88 address signs for the Jerusalem Valley Road Area. We will be working with the County on the road re-naming and addressing project.

Earlier this year we received donations of \$12,000.00 from the Lake County Wine Alliance, and \$5,000.00 from the Rockridge Foundation. We are using those funds to purchase a new Lake County Red Net Repeater to improve radio communications for SLCF on Lake Red. That purchase has been started and allocation for use of those funds by Resolution is forthcoming.

The Electrical Safety Prop here at Station 60 had the story Boards installed last week. We are nearing completion on that project. We would like to have a small dedication in the Spring of 2021 to recognize the people the prop is dedicated to.

Loch Lomond Station 64 had the toilets and sinks installed this week. Additional repairs and improvements are ongoing to that facility.

Chairman Moke Simon advised the Rancheria was awarded the funds for the NWS/NOAA project to be placed on Mt. St. Helena. There is no implementation or purchase date.

Please accept my apologies. I'm on finance assignment for the Glass fire and can only offer brief finance communications.

Payroll hours totaled over 1300, of which 90% of these hours are for mutual aid/assistance by hire. These hours are paid up front before the Fire District. A couple of the budget transfers on under consent calendar are to cover the overtime expense paid up front. This will be adjusted later in the fiscal year when OES funds are received.

Budget summary represents about 45% of the fiscal year. Note what is not represented under expenditures is the Cal Fire invoice since this isn't received until December and January, and under revenue, property tax and direct charges/assessments, as these aren't available until payments from property tax bills are received in December.

The County Clerk's Office noticed the district of its biennial review for its Conflict of Interest Code and requires the return of the attached verification.

The code last updated September 20, 2016 by Resolution No 2016-17-06 is attached for review. The biennial review notice notes the Code be reviewed and verified that it:

- 1) Accurately designates all positions that make or participate in the making of governmental decisions; and,
- 2) Disclosures assigned to those positions accurately requires that all investments, business positions, interests in real property, and sources of income that may be foreseeably be affected materially by the decisions made by those holding designated positions are reported; and,
- 3) Code includes all other provisions required by Government Code §87302 (attached):
 - a. Requirement of designated positions file statements disclosing items listed under 2) at times and under circumstances, i.e. initial statement upon 30 days of assuming office, annually thereafter, and within 30 days upon leaving office; and,
 - b. Designated position must disqualify themselves from making, participating in making, or using position to influence the making of any decision.

Upon my review, I recommend the Board consider:

- -Adopting attached resolutions, which,
- 1) Removes abolished Fire Marshal position and designates the 5 Directors, Fire Chief, Battalion Chief, who are the positions that make or participate in the making of governmental decisions; and,
- 2) Requires designees to disclose:
 - a. All investments; and,
 - b. All business positions in which the designee is a director, trustee, officer, partner, employee or any position of management; and,
 - c. Interests in real property; and,
 - d. All sources of income which may be foreseeably be affected materially by decisions made by those holding the designated position.
- 3) By incorporation of reference, the Fair Political Practices Commission, California Code of Regulations, Title 2, §18730,

- a. Designates times and circumstances designated positions are required to file statements of disclosure; and,
- b. Designates position to determine when he/she must disqualify themselves from making, participating in making, or using position to influence the making of any decision.

Disclosures: 1) All income, investments, interests, and business positions in any business entity which does now or is likely to do business within the District; 2) All interests in real property or interests (or business positions) in any business, which owns real property, if the property is located within the District or within two miles of its boundaries; 3) All income and investment interests, and business positions in any business entity or source of income which are contractors or subcontractors engaged in the performance of work or services of the type utilized by the department or District for which the designated employee is Manager, Director, or Employee; 4) All income and investment interests, and business positions in any business entity or source of income which does business with the District or has done business with the District during the two years prior to the time a statement is required to be filed hereunder which manufacture or sell supplies, books, machinery, or equipment of the type utilized by the department or District in which the designated employee is Director, Manager or an employee; and

GOVERNMENT CODE

Section 87302

87302. Each Conflict of Interest Code shall contain the following provisions:

- (a) Specific enumeration of the positions within the agency, other than those specified in Section 87200, which involve the making or participation in the making of decisions which may foreseeably have a material effect on any financial interest and for each such enumerated position, the specific types of investments, business positions, interests in real property, and sources of income which are reportable. An investment, business position, interest in real property, or source of income shall be made reportable by the Conflict of Interest Code if the business entity in which the investment or business position is held, the interest in real property, or the income or source of income may foreseeably be affected materially by any decision made or participated in by the designated employee by virtue of his or her position.
- (b) Requirements that each designated employee, other than those specified in Section 87200, file statements at times and under circumstances described in this section, disclosing reportable investments, business positions, interests in real property and income. The information disclosed with respect to reportable investments, interests in real property, and income shall be the same as the information required by Sections 87206 and 87207. The first statement filed under a Conflict of Interest Code by a designated employee shall disclose any reportable investments, business positions, interests in real property, and income. An initial statement shall be filed by each designated employee within 30 days after the effective date of the Conflict of Interest Code, disclosing investments, business positions, and interests in real property held on the effective date of the Conflict of Interest Code and income received during the 12 months before the effective date of the Conflict of Interest Code. Thereafter, each new designated employee shall file a statement within 30 days after assuming office, or if subject to State Senate confirmation, 30 days after being appointed or nominated, disclosing investments, business positions, and interests in real property held on, and income received during the 12 months before, the date of assuming office or the date of being appointed or nominated, respectively. Each designated employee shall file an annual statement, at the time specified in the Conflict of Interest Code, disclosing reportable investments, business positions, interest in real property and income held or received at any time during the previous calendar year or since the date the designated employee took office if during the calendar year. Every designated employee who leaves office shall file, within 30 days of leaving office, a statement disclosing reportable investments, business positions, interests in real property, and income held or received at any time during the period between the closing date of the last statement required to be filed and the date of leaving office.

- (c) Specific provisions setting forth any circumstances under which designated employees or categories of designated employees must disqualify themselves from making, participating in the making, or using their official position to influence the making of any decision. Disqualification shall be required by the Conflict of Interest Code when the designated employee has a financial interest as defined in Section 87103, which it is reasonably foreseeable may be affected materially by the decision. No designated employee shall be required to disqualify himself or herself with respect to any matter which could not legally be acted upon or decided without his or her participation.
- (d) For any position enumerated pursuant to subdivision (a), an individual who resigns the position within 12 months following initial appointment or within 30 days of the date of a notice mailed by the filing officer of the individual's filing obligation, whichever is earlier, is not deemed to assume or leave office, provided that during the period between appointment and resignation, the individual does not make, participate in making, or use the position to influence any decision of the agency or receive, or become entitled to receive, any form of payment by virtue of being appointed to the position. Within 30 days of the date of a notice mailed by the filing officer, the individual shall do both of the following:
 - (1) File a written resignation with the appointing power.
- (2) File a written statement with the filing officer on a form prescribed by the commission and signed under the penalty of perjury stating that the individual, during the period between appointment and resignation, did not make, participate in the making, or use the position to influence any decision of the agency or receive, or become entitled to receive, any form of payment by virtue of being appointed to the position.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, The Political Reform Act, Government Code §81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted California Code of Regulations, Title 2, §18730, that contains the terms of a standard Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the South Lake County Fire Protection District Board of Directors adopts the terms California Code of Regulations, Title 2, §18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and constitute the Conflict of Interest Code for the South Lake County Fire Protection District (District), which is to remain in full force and effect until amended, along with the following designated positions and disclosures:

Designated Officers: Board of Directors (5 members)

22 Fire Chief

23 Battalion Chief

Disclosures: 1) All income, investments, interests, and business positions in any business entity which does now or is likely to do business within the District; 2) All interests in real property or interests (or business positions) in any business, which owns real property, if the property is located within the District or within two miles of its boundaries; 3) All income and investment interests, and business positions in any business entity or source of income which are contractors or subcontractors engaged in the performance of work or services of the type utilized by the department or District for which the designated employee is Manager, Director, or Employee; 4) All income and investment interests, and business positions in any business entity or source of income which does business with the District or has done business with the District during the two years prior to the time a statement is required to be filed hereunder which manufacture or sell supplies, books, machinery, or equipment of the type utilized by the department or District in which the designated employee is Director, Manager or an employee; and

(Regulations of the Fair Political Practices Commission, Title 2, Division 6, California Code of Regulations.)

§ 18730. Provisions of Conflict of Interest Codes.

- (a) Incorporation by reference of the terms of this regulation along with the designation of employees and the formulation of disclosure categories in the Appendix referred to below constitute the adoption and promulgation of a conflict of interest code within the meaning of Section 87300 or the amendment of a conflict of interest code within the meaning of Section 87306 if the terms of this regulation are substituted for terms of a conflict of interest code already in effect. A code so amended or adopted and promulgated requires the reporting of reportable items in a manner substantially equivalent to the requirements of article 2 of chapter 7 of the Political Reform Act, Sections 81000, et seq. The requirements of a conflict of interest code are in addition to other requirements of the Political Reform Act, such as the general prohibition against conflicts of interest contained in Section 87100, and to other state or local laws pertaining to conflicts of interest.
- (b) The terms of a conflict of interest code amended or adopted and promulgated pursuant to this regulation are as follows:
 - (1) Section 1. Definitions.

The definitions contained in the Political Reform Act of 1974, regulations of the Fair Political Practices Commission (Regulations 18110, et seq.), and any amendments to the Act or regulations, are incorporated by reference into this conflict of interest code.

(2) Section 2. Designated Employees.

The persons holding positions listed in the Appendix are designated employees. It has been determined that these persons make or participate in the making of decisions which may foreseeably have a material effect on economic interests.

(3) Section 3. Disclosure Categories.

This code does not establish any disclosure obligation for those designated employees who are also specified in Section 87200 if they are designated in this code in that same capacity or if the geographical jurisdiction of this agency is the same as or is wholly included within the jurisdiction in which those persons must report their economic interests pursuant to article 2 of chapter 7 of the Political Reform Act, Sections 87200, et seq.

In addition, this code does not establish any disclosure obligation for any designated employees who are designated in a conflict of interest code for another agency, if all of the following apply:

- (A) The geographical jurisdiction of this agency is the same as or is wholly included within the jurisdiction of the other agency;
- (B) The disclosure assigned in the code of the other agency is the same as that required under article 2 of chapter 7 of the Political Reform Act, Section 87200; and
 - (C) The filing officer is the same for both agencies.1

Such persons are covered by this code for disqualification purposes only. With respect to all other designated employees, the disclosure categories set forth in the Appendix specify which kinds of economic interests are reportable. Such a designated employee shall disclose in his or her statement of economic interests those economic interests he or she has which are of the kind described in the disclosure categories to which he or she is assigned in the Appendix. It has been determined that the economic interests set forth in a designated employee's disclosure categories

are the kinds of economic interests which he or she foreseeably can affect materially through the conduct of his or her office.

(4) Section 4. Statements of Economic Interests: Place of Filing.

The code reviewing body shall instruct all designated employees within its code to file statements of economic interests with the agency or with the code reviewing body, as provided by the code reviewing body in the agency's conflict of interest code.2

- (5) Section 5. Statements of Economic Interests: Time of Filing.
- (A) Initial Statements. All designated employees employed by the agency on the effective date of this code, as originally adopted, promulgated and approved by the code reviewing body, shall file statements within 30 days after the effective date of this code. Thereafter, each person already in a position when it is designated by an amendment to this code shall file an initial statement within 30 days after the effective date of the amendment.
- (B) Assuming Office Statements. All persons assuming designated positions after the effective date of this code shall file statements within 30 days after assuming the designated positions, or if subject to State Senate confirmation, 30 days after being nominated or appointed.
- (C) Annual Statements. All designated employees shall file statements no later than April 1. If a person reports for military service as defined in the Servicemember's Civil Relief Act, the deadline for the annual statement of economic interests is 30 days following his or her return to office, provided the person, or someone authorized to represent the person's interests, notifies the filing officer in writing prior to the applicable filing deadline that he or she is subject to that federal statute and is unable to meet the applicable deadline, and provides the filing officer verification of his or her military status.

- (D) Leaving Office Statements. All persons who leave designated positions shall file statements within 30 days after leaving office.
 - (5.5) Section 5.5. Statements for Persons Who Resign Prior to Assuming Office.

Any person who resigns within 12 months of initial appointment, or within 30 days of the date of notice provided by the filing officer to file an assuming office statement, is not deemed to have assumed office or left office, provided he or she did not make or participate in the making of, or use his or her position to influence any decision and did not receive or become entitled to receive any form of payment as a result of his or her appointment. Such persons shall not file either an assuming or leaving office statement.

- (A) Any person who resigns a position within 30 days of the date of a notice from the filing officer shall do both of the following:
 - (1) File a written resignation with the appointing power; and
- (2) File a written statement with the filing officer declaring under penalty of perjury that during the period between appointment and resignation he or she did not make, participate in the making, or use the position to influence any decision of the agency or receive, or become entitled to receive, any form of payment by virtue of being appointed to the position.
 - (6) Section 6. Contents of and Period Covered by Statements of Economic Interests.
 - (A) Contents of Initial Statements.

Initial statements shall disclose any reportable investments, interests in real property and business positions held on the effective date of the code and income received during the 12 months prior to the effective date of the code.

(B) Contents of Assuming Office Statements.

Assuming office statements shall disclose any reportable investments, interests in real property and business positions held on the date of assuming office or, if subject to State Senate confirmation or appointment, on the date of nomination, and income received during the 12 months prior to the date of assuming office or the date of being appointed or nominated, respectively.

- (C) Contents of Annual Statements. Annual statements shall disclose any reportable investments, interests in real property, income and business positions held or received during the previous calendar year provided, however, that the period covered by an employee's first annual statement shall begin on the effective date of the code or the date of assuming office whichever is later, or for a board or commission member subject to Section 87302.6, the day after the closing date of the most recent statement filed by the member pursuant to Regulation 18754.
- Leaving office statements shall disclose reportable investments, interests in real property, income and business positions held or received during the period between the closing date of the last statement filed and the date of leaving office.
- (7) Section 7. Manner of Reporting.Statements of economic interests shall be made on forms prescribed by the Fair PoliticalPractices Commission and supplied by the agency, and shall contain the following information:
- When an investment or an interest in real property3 is required to be reported,4 the statement shall contain the following:
 - 1. A statement of the nature of the investment or interest;

(A) Investment and Real Property Disclosure.

(D) Contents of Leaving Office Statements.

- 2. The name of the business entity in which each investment is held, and a general description of the business activity in which the business entity is engaged;
 - 3. The address or other precise location of the real property;
- 4. A statement whether the fair market value of the investment or interest in real property equals or exceeds \$2,000, exceeds \$10,000, exceeds \$100,000, or exceeds \$1,000,000.
- (B) Personal Income Disclosure. When personal income is required to be reported,5 the statement shall contain:
- 1. The name and address of each source of income aggregating \$500 or more in value, or \$50 or more in value if the income was a gift, and a general description of the business activity, if any, of each source;
- 2. A statement whether the aggregate value of income from each source, or in the case of a loan, the highest amount owed to each source, was \$1,000 or less, greater than \$1,000, greater than \$10,000, or greater than \$100,000;
 - 3. A description of the consideration, if any, for which the income was received;
- 4. In the case of a gift, the name, address and business activity of the donor and any intermediary through which the gift was made; a description of the gift; the amount or value of the gift; and the date on which the gift was received;
- 5. In the case of a loan, the annual interest rate and the security, if any, given for the loan and the term of the loan.
- (C) Business Entity Income Disclosure. When income of a business entity, including income of a sole proprietorship, is required to be reported,6 the statement shall contain:
- 1. The name, address, and a general description of the business activity of the business entity;

- 2. The name of every person from whom the business entity received payments if the filer's pro rata share of gross receipts from such person was equal to or greater than \$10,000.
- (D) Business Position Disclosure. When business positions are required to be reported, a designated employee shall list the name and address of each business entity in which he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or in which he or she holds any position of management, a description of the business activity in which the business entity is engaged, and the designated employee's position with the business entity.
- (E) Acquisition or Disposal During Reporting Period. In the case of an annual or leaving office statement, if an investment or an interest in real property was partially or wholly acquired or disposed of during the period covered by the statement, the statement shall contain the date of acquisition or disposal.
 - (8) Section 8. Prohibition on Receipt of Honoraria.
- (A) No member of a state board or commission, and no designated employee of a state or local government agency, shall accept any honorarium from any source, if the member or employee would be required to report the receipt of income or gifts from that source on his or her statement of economic interests.
- (B) This section shall not apply to any part-time member of the governing board of any public institution of higher education, unless the member is also an elected official.
- (C) Subdivisions (a), (b), and (c) of Section 89501 shall apply to the prohibitions in this section.
- (D) This section shall not limit or prohibit payments, advances, or reimbursements for travel and related lodging and subsistence authorized by Section 89506.
 - (8.1) Section 8.1. Prohibition on Receipt of Gifts in Excess of \$500.

- (A) No member of a state board or commission, and no designated employee of a state or local government agency, shall accept gifts with a total value of more than \$500 in a calendar year from any single source, if the member or employee would be required to report the receipt of income or gifts from that source on his or her statement of economic interests.
- (B) This section shall not apply to any part-time member of the governing board of any public institution of higher education, unless the member is also an elected official.
- (C) Subdivisions (e), (f), and (g) of Section 89503 shall apply to the prohibitions in this section.
 - (8.2) Section 8.2. Loans to Public Officials.
- (A) No elected officer of a state or local government agency shall, from the date of his or her election to office through the date that he or she vacates office, receive a personal loan from any officer, employee, member, or consultant of the state or local government agency in which the elected officer holds office or over which the elected officer's agency has direction and control.
- (B) No public official who is exempt from the state civil service system pursuant to subdivisions (c), (d), (e), (f), and (g) of Section 4 of Article VII of the Constitution shall, while he or she holds office, receive a personal loan from any officer, employee, member, or consultant of the state or local government agency in which the public official holds office or over which the public official's agency has direction and control. This subdivision shall not apply to loans made to a public official whose duties are solely secretarial, clerical, or manual.
- (C) No elected officer of a state or local government agency shall, from the date of his or her election to office through the date that he or she vacates office, receive a personal loan from any person who has a contract with the state or local government agency to which that elected

officer has been elected or over which that elected officer's agency has direction and control.

This subdivision shall not apply to loans made by banks or other financial institutions or to any indebtedness created as part of a retail installment or credit card transaction, if the loan is made or the indebtedness created in the lender's regular course of business on terms available to members of the public without regard to the elected officer's official status.

- (D) No public official who is exempt from the state civil service system pursuant to subdivisions (c), (d), (e), (f), and (g) of Section 4 of Article VII of the Constitution shall, while he or she holds office, receive a personal loan from any person who has a contract with the state or local government agency to which that elected officer has been elected or over which that elected officer's agency has direction and control. This subdivision shall not apply to loans made by banks or other financial institutions or to any indebtedness created as part of a retail installment or credit card transaction, if the loan is made or the indebtedness created in the lender's regular course of business on terms available to members of the public without regard to the elected officer's official status. This subdivision shall not apply to loans made to a public official whose duties are solely secretarial, clerical, or manual.
 - (E) This section shall not apply to the following:
- 1. Loans made to the campaign committee of an elected officer or candidate for elective office.
- 2. Loans made by a public official's spouse, child, parent, grandparent, grandchild, brother, sister, parent-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, nephew, niece, aunt, uncle, or first cousin, or the spouse of any such persons, provided that the person making the loan is not acting as an agent or intermediary for any person not otherwise exempted under this section.
 - 3. Loans from a person which, in the aggregate, do not exceed \$500 at any given time.

- 4. Loans made, or offered in writing, before January 1, 1998.
- (8.3) Section 8.3. Loan Terms.
- (A) Except as set forth in subdivision (B), no elected officer of a state or local government agency shall, from the date of his or her election to office through the date he or she vacates office, receive a personal loan of \$500 or more, except when the loan is in writing and clearly states the terms of the loan, including the parties to the loan agreement, date of the loan, amount of the loan, term of the loan, date or dates when payments shall be due on the loan and the amount of the payments, and the rate of interest paid on the loan.
 - (B) This section shall not apply to the following types of loans:
 - 1. Loans made to the campaign committee of the elected officer.
- 2. Loans made to the elected officer by his or her spouse, child, parent, grandparent, grandchild, brother, sister, parent-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, nephew, niece, aunt, uncle, or first cousin, or the spouse of any such person, provided that the person making the loan is not acting as an agent or intermediary for any person not otherwise exempted under this section.
 - 3. Loans made, or offered in writing, before January 1, 1998.
- (C) Nothing in this section shall exempt any person from any other provision of Title 9 of the Government Code.
 - (8.4) Section 8.4. Personal Loans.
- (A) Except as set forth in subdivision (B), a personal loan received by any designated employee shall become a gift to the designated employee for the purposes of this section in the following circumstances:
